



The Nominating Committee hopes that you will consider stepping up by contacting a Nominating Committee member or, if asked, responding with a "Yes, I will serve!"


Kids Love UU Weekend

# SOCIAL ACTION and INCLUSIVITY



Albany UU Planned-Parenthood Partnership group participated in Upper Hudson's Planned Parenthood's "Lobby Day." This event was a coalescence of months of grass roots efforts, advocacy, and support. During the event, Gov. Kathy Hochul, along with many others, spoke in support of bodily autonomy and reproductive justice.

These voices were heard, and the NY State Assembly voted Yes in favor of a constitutional amendment cementing reproductive rights for women, people of color, and all folx across the LGBTia2S+ spectrum (which will go to voters in 2024).

Many members of the Upper Hudson Planned-Parenthood team personally expressed gratitude for the congregation's generous support and financial contributions. Financial contributions from "private" organizations have less restrictions than government grants; allowing greater leeway for Upper Hudson to continue supporting, educating, and fighting for reproductive justice
