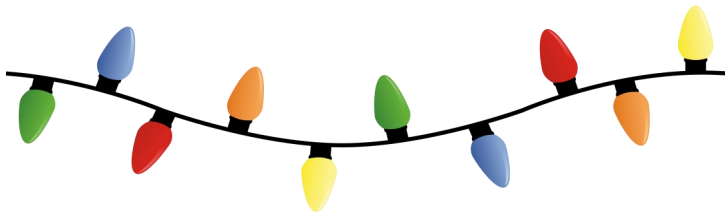


Albany UU Holiday Events
