On 8 June 1967, the fourth day of the Six-Day War, Israeli planes attacked the USS Liberty, an American surveillance ship, killing 34 crew members, wounding 174 and nearly sinking the ship. The Israeli government claimed it was a tragic accident based on mistaken identity. The government of US President Johnson publicly accepted that highly questionable excuse.
