The Values We Share and How We - Want to Express Them in Our Community? - A Survey

The Unitarian Universalist Principles are the values that bind us to other American UU congregations. By contrast, Albany UU's Mission Statement summarizes what our congregation is and what it aims to achieve. Though critical for how our whole congregation behaves, neither of these documents addresses how the members of our congregation should relate to each other. A covenant, serving as a formal guide to how we want to treat each other, can enhance our ability to participate in a satisfying community and to achieve our mission.

We celebrate our sense that we are a community of diverse beliefs, united by shared values. Let's explore what these shared values are, and how they instruct our behavior towards each other. If we can identify and articulate them in a meaningful covenant, we will have a guide for supporting each other as we deepen the meaning and joy of our community and speed our journey towards fulfilling our Society's mission.

This survey seeks your help in determining which behaviors you consider most important for creating a meaningful, effective and rewarding religious community. In addition, we need you to tell us which of these ought to be included in a covenant as a guide to member behavior. To that end, below is a list of behaviors which we frequently acknowledge as contributing to a valued community, behaviors included in the covenants of other congregations and space for you to suggest unlisted behaviors you consider critical.

For <u>each</u> behavior in the list below, please indicate in the columns to the right:

- 1) Is the behavior important for community (Y/N) and
- 2) This behavior should be in our covenant. (Y/N).

In deciding yes or no for each behavior, don't focus on the particular wording, but on the idea expressed. We are not trying to write a covenant here, but surveying the utility of concepts and ideas. The actual covenant language will likely be different than the language used here.
