

Revised Albany UU Building Use Guidelines As of 9/10/21

These guidelines have been developed to accommodate current COVID-related conditions using the information available at this time. As conditions change, these guidelines will be updated accordingly. These revised guidelines supersede all previous guidelines.

Guidance for Church Groups (non-rentals) meeting inside the Albany UU building

- Always provide an option for remote participation, via video conference and/or telephone
- Everyone is expected to wear a mask while in the church building regardless of vaccination status
- No eating except as necessary for health reasons and for staff
- Upon entering the building, sign in at the Welcome Table in case of later need for public health contact tracing
- No special cleaning is required; however, each group is expected to tidy up after use and leave the space as it was found or better

Guidance for Church Groups (non-rentals) meeting outside, on or off church property

- Always provide an option for remote participation, via videoconference and/or telephone
- Follow prevailing public health guidelines for outdoor gatherings

Guidance for Renters

All rental groups are responsible for minimizing Covid spread. Rental Groups will be apprised of AUU building use policy and are responsible for the conduct of their guests and enforcement of current public health guidelines for infectious disease control, as defined by the Albany County Department of Health. AUU will not enforce these guidelines for outside groups regardless of risk level. Rental contracts are written according to public health considerations on the date signed. If there is a change in those conditions that affect federal, state or local guidance rental contracts may be amended or cancelled. In the case of a public health cancellation, renters will be refunded.
