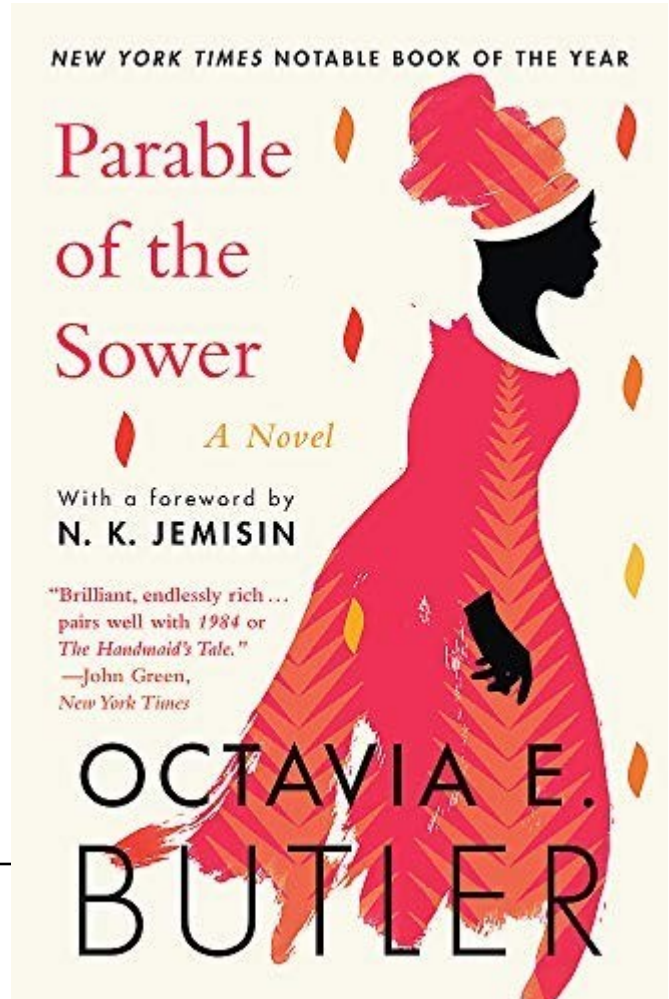
OCTAVIA BUTLER'S NOVEL *PARABLE OF THE SOWER*

First Unitarian Universalist Society of Albany's Rev. Sam Trumbore is organizing a book study class to introduce the deep theology and cultural analysis found in Octavia Butler's Afro-Futurism novels. The source for the class is a podcast called Octavia's Parables by Adrienne Maree Brown and Toshi Reagon.
