Simply put: we sell secondhand clothes and send the money to local grassroots initiatives.

Thrift 2 Fight recently won a grant from Davis Projects for Peace, which sponsored this journey across New York State to raise funds for racial justice work, make community connections, and foster the love for thrifted clothing.

- We only accept adult clothing & accessories that are clean and in good condition. Please avoid bringing items that are dirty, stained, ripped, broken, or funky-smelling.
- Fold the clothing if possible. It would make us very happy and substantially speed up the pricing/sorting process.
- If you would like to donate shoes, please make sure that they are gently used or new.

WE DO NOT ACCEPT: books, children's items, furniture, dishes or kitchenware, underwear, used socks/tights/stockings/etc., linens, bathrobes, towels, pillows, blankets, toys.

Please remember that the main purpose of our sales is to raise much needed funds for grassroots racial justice work. Only include items that you think we can sell. Thank you!
