

Hints and Tips for Using Our Website

On the homepage of our new site, up at the top, you'll see the word "RESOURCES". If you click on that word, it will take you to a page with most of the resources that members will need, such as the file cabinet, archives, the link to the ET Grant Form, the secure site, Church DB, etc. It's all there.

If you're looking for our online giving resources, such as the link to set up recurring online payments using your credit card or eChecks and a link to our current Stewardship Campaign and pledge form, you'll find the word "GIVE" to the left of "RESOURCES" on the top of the home page. Click on that and from there, you can find out all the options and ways to contribute to Albany UU.

A handy feature of our website is the "three bars and magnifying glass" menu. That is located to the right of "RESOURCES" on the top of our homepage. When you click on that, it will drop down a menu with many important quick links to pages that you may be looking for.

Also on the homepage you will find:

- Direct links to important Sunday Service information, Social Action and Inclusivity by clicking on the photo icon of each.
- There are also links to Covid Updates and our Health Screening Form
- Below that, you will find three Pictures with "plus signs" at the bottom of each. When you click on the plus sign, that will bring up menus for Religious Education, Staying Connected or resources for First Time Visitors.
