## Application for FUUSA Endowment Trust Grants

The Endowment Trust (ET) of the First Unitarian Universalist Society of Albany (FUUSA) seeks to promote the Society's mission by providing grants from its earnings to support special Society projects or mission-related expenses. It is expected, though not required, that grants be used for start-up or other one-time activities or acquisitions, rather than for recurring expenses.

The application process consists of submitting this application to any member of the ET Board or to the ET box in the FUUSA office. Projects will be considered on a first-come, first-served basis. Grants will be awarded according to the following criteria:

- 1. degree to which a project or expense promotes FUUSA's mission;
- 2. unavailability of funds from other sources;
- 3. amount available for granting in a particular grant cycle;
- 4. relative merit of an application compared to other competing applications during a grant cycle.
