Service Opportunity Name/Title: Circle Dinner Host

Service Opportunity Brief Description:

Host a Circle Dinner, the purpose of which is to encourage community among members of the congregation, with emphasis on integrating new members.

Service Opportunity Detailed Description:

The Circle Dinner Host organizes and hosts a “potluck” dinner at their home, welcoming members of the congregation who have been selected to attend their event by the Circle Dinner Coordinator.

Upon receiving an email from the Circle Dinner Coordinator, the Host contacts the participants assigned to their home, to organize the dinner menu. The Host normally provides the main dish and offers guidance to the participants for what they can bring to the dinner. It is not necessary to cook the menu items. The goal of the dinner is fellowship, so supplying your favorite takeout food is fine! The Host also provides direction to their home.

Circle Dinners are held from 6pm to 9 pm, so Hosts must be ready to receive guests at those times. As is normal for any dinner party, the Host must ensure that there are enough seats for their guests and there is enough space for guests to mingle and have fun.

Length of Service Commitment: 1 evening

This opportunity will enable you to help members find fellowship and have fun; feel a sense of accomplishment for hosting a successful dinner.

Skills Needed: No specific skills are required.

Training, assistance, and safety requirements: No specific training is required.
