A non-refundable deposit of \$50 for each adult and child (ages 6-17) is due with reservations. **Reservations received by June 18 qualify for last year's rates, those received June 19-Sept. 18 pay regular rates and reservations received after Sept. 18, pay an additional late fee.** All balances are due by Oct. 1. Refunds will be made, except for deposits, if written notification is received prior to noon, Oct. 6. If special accommodations are needed, you must register before Sept. 18.
