The SJT has approved the MMAA (Modern Military Association of America) to receive the pass the plate. MMAA is an advocacy organization for LGBTQIA2S+ servicemembers and former servicemembers, including updating DD214 (Discharge papers) for folx of all identities (including transgender) who were unjustly discharged "dishonorably."

Jim Scott's songs (like "Gather the Spirit") are in our Unitarian Universalist hymnals. He's lead services and performed concerts at more than 700 UU churches over the course of 35 years. As co-chair of the UU Ministry for the Earth, Jim was one of the creators of the Green Sanctuary program. A longtime member of the Paul Winter Consort, Jim was co-composer of their celebrated "Missa Gaia/Earth Mass." He has produced 9 albums and created the "Earth and Spirit Songbook."
